Question 1

2.1.3 Players should put on a suitable face covering, either face mask or face shield, before entering the premises.

Answer 1

Broadly it is accepted that people don't wear masks during physical activity. If the activity is passive it may be appropriate and decrease risk.

Short Mat Bowls is a passive activity and therefore masks should be worn.

Question 2

If a player is a member of more than 1 club can they play in more than 1 club.

Answer 2

Each Sport / Club / Player will need to risk assess that item as part of the move to personal responsibility. Playing across multiple clubs and in multiple venues with multiple people may create an overall higher risk.

This has to be built into the risk assessment.

Question 3

If a person has completed your Covid E-learning course in 2020 do they have to resit it again?

Answer 3
